

Prescribing Paxlovid Checklist

Review this checklist before prescribing Paxlovid to your patients.



Reviewed Eligibility

- Positive COVID test
- Starting drug within 5 days of symptoms
- Symptoms are mild to moderate
- Reviewed medications/medical history
- Patient is not pregnant
- Patient age is >12 years



Reviewed Medication List

Review drug classes for potential interactions with Paxlovid, including:

- Alpha1-adrenoreceptor antagonist (BPH drug)
- Analgesics
- Anti-anginal
- Antiarrhythmic
- Anti-gout
- Antipsychotics
- Ergot derivatives
- Statins
- Sedatives/hypnotics
- PDE5 inhibitors

Reviewed Medical History

Contraindications include: liver disease, severe kidney disease and drug incompatibilities. Consider discontinuation of incompatible drugs for 8 days while taking Paxlovid. Consider renal dose for patients with kidney disease.
